





Assure, Green Shield and ESI

- These drug plans have alternative bill codes AY, G1 and EY
- An alternative bill code is used to distinguish between a cardholder and anyone other then the cardholder, for example a spouse card
- Another reason to use it is for smart cards to distinguish between the cardholder or spouse drug plan and the smart card

AR Account Receivable

- There are many AR bill codes, XA-X0 and X0-X9, the general one is AR
- Attaching a AR bill code to a patient's record will allow prescription amounts to be transferred to their charge account in the PharmaClik POS system
- Bill code Plan Names can be customized in List Maintenance under Accounts Receivable Preferences

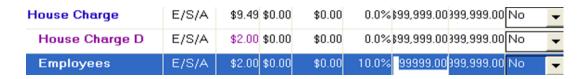


House Charge

- There are many house charges, H0-H9 and HA-HZ the general one is HC
- House charges can be used for specific groups of people to set special pricing
- Bill code Plan Names can be customized in List Maintenance under House Charge Preferences
- In order for the bill code to work it must be set as the first drug plan.

Example 1 - Employee Special Pricing

In the **Pricing** tab add a House Charge where Plan Name is **Employees** and set the **Fee** to \$2.00 with a 10% **Markup**.



Example 2 - Waving an Amount for Specific Patients

In the **Var. Pricing** tab add a House Charge named **Waive 3 Dollars** and set the **%Fee** to **-1** to remove the dispensing fee then put in a **Fixed \$** of \$6.99.
