

## Atlantic Pricing - Provincial Differences

- MLS (Manufacturer List Price) is the default supplier for pricing of drugs
- Stores must be registered to receive updates for MLS

### New Brunswick

- Provincial bill code is **NP\*** (New Brunswick Provincial Drug Plan - NBPDP)

### Newfoundland/Labrador

- Provincial bill code is **FD\*** (Newfoundland & Labrador Prescription Drug Program - NLPDP)
- All prescriptions (except patients identified with **Animal** status) must pass through the NLPN/NLCHI (Newfoundland and Labrador Pharmacy Network), also known as the DIS (Drug Information System)

### Nova Scotia

- Provincial bill code is **MS\*** (Nova Scotia Pharmacare)
- PMP (Prescription Monitoring Program) – Pharmacies are required to submit dispensing information about all monitored drugs to PMP - bill code is **PM**

### Prince Edward Island

- No standard provincial bill code
- All prescriptions for residents of PEI must pass through the DIS (Drug Information System) except for patients with a status of “Out of Province” or “Animal”.
- The markup must be incorporated into the cost of the prescription
